MOROCCO - EGYPT TOUR ITINERARY

DAY 1: HOME – MOROCCO (CASABLANCA)

Upon arrival in Morocco, you will be welcomed by our representative and taken on a short 10-minute drive to a nearby rest area restaurant. Here, you will have time to freshen up, offer prayers, and enjoy a traditional Moroccan lunch with refreshing tea. After lunch, we continue with a 45-minute drive to your hotel, where you can rest and relax for a few hours.

Later in the afternoon, we visit the magnificent Hassan II Mosque, a stunning architectural masterpiece located by the Atlantic Ocean. As one of the largest mosques in the world, it offers breathtaking views and an unparalleled spiritual experience. We will aim to perform Maghrib prayer at this mosque to enhance your experience.

In the evening, we take a scenic drive to Ain-Diab, a coastal area known for its vibrant dining scene. Enjoy a delicious dinner at a local restaurant with views of the Atlantic Ocean before returning to the hotel for an overnight stay.

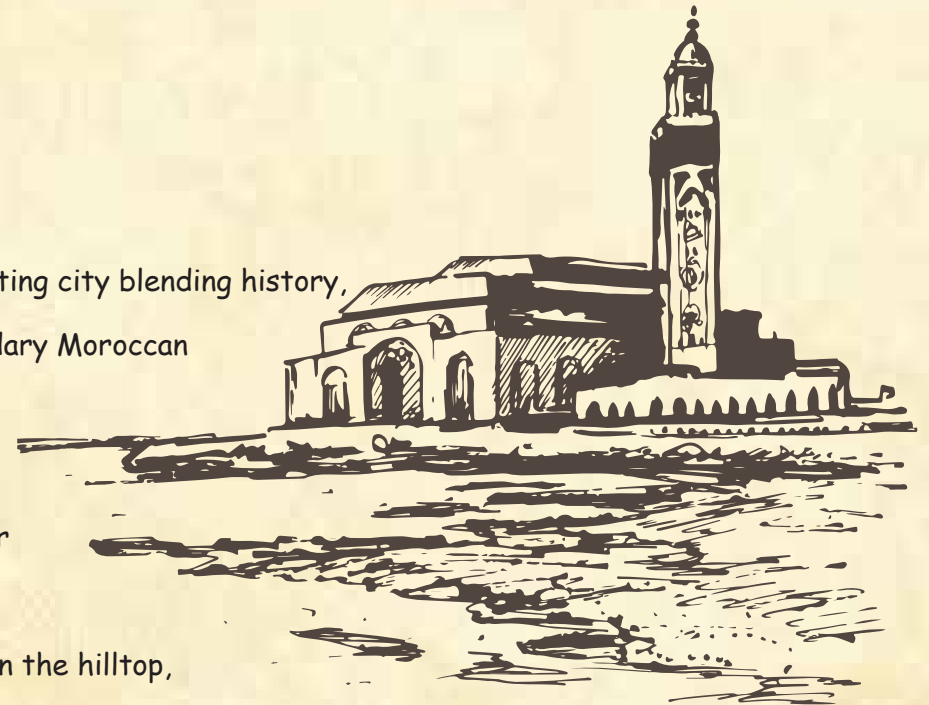

DAY 2: CASABLANCA – TANGIER

After breakfast at the hotel, we set off on a scenic drive to Tangier, a fascinating city blending history, culture, and nature. Upon arrival, we visit the Ibn Battuta Tomb, honoring the legendary Moroccan explorer.

Next, we explore the Hercules Caves, located on the Atlantic coast. These caves are famous for their striking entrance shaped like the map of Africa and offer a glimpse into ancient mythology and local legends.

Later in the afternoon, we head to the Kasbah, an ancient fortress perched on the hilltop,



offering panoramic views of the Mediterranean Sea and Tangier's old town. Afterward, we drive to the hotel for check-in, followed by dinner at the hotel.

DAY 3: TANGIER – CHEFCHAOUEN – FEZ

Known as the "Blue Pearl," Chefchaouen's picturesque streets and blue-washed buildings make it one of Morocco's most unique and beautiful destinations. Stroll through its narrow alleyways and take in the peaceful atmosphere.

Following our exploration of Chefchaouen, we continue our journey to Fez. Upon arrival, we check in at the hotel and enjoy dinner. For those interested, an optional evening visit to the Medina of Fez can be arranged. This historic old town is famous for its lively souks, intricate architecture, and vibrant culture.

DAY 4: FEZ – MEKNES

After breakfast, we dedicate the day to exploring the cultural and historical gems of Fez. Our first stop is the Al-Quaraouiyine Mosque and University, one of the oldest universities in the world, founded in 859 AD. We also visit the traditional leather tanning center, a must-see for its fascinating centuries-old practices.



Next, we visit the Moulay Idriss II Mausoleum, which honors the founder of Fez and offers insight into Morocco's spiritual heritage. In the afternoon, we take a short drive to Meknes, another imperial city, where we explore the Moulay Idriss Zerhoun area and the ancient Volubilis ruins, showcasing remarkable 17th-century architecture. After the tour, we return to the hotel in Fez for dinner

DAY 5: FEZ – IFRANE – RABAT – MOHAMMEDIA

Following breakfast, we drive to Ifrane, a city known for its unique Swiss-inspired architecture and cooler climate. After exploring Ifrane, we continue to Rabat, the capital of Morocco. In Rabat, we visit the Hassan Tower, an unfinished minaret from the 12th century, and the Mausoleum of Mohammed V, a magnificent structure housing the tombs of the late king and his sons.

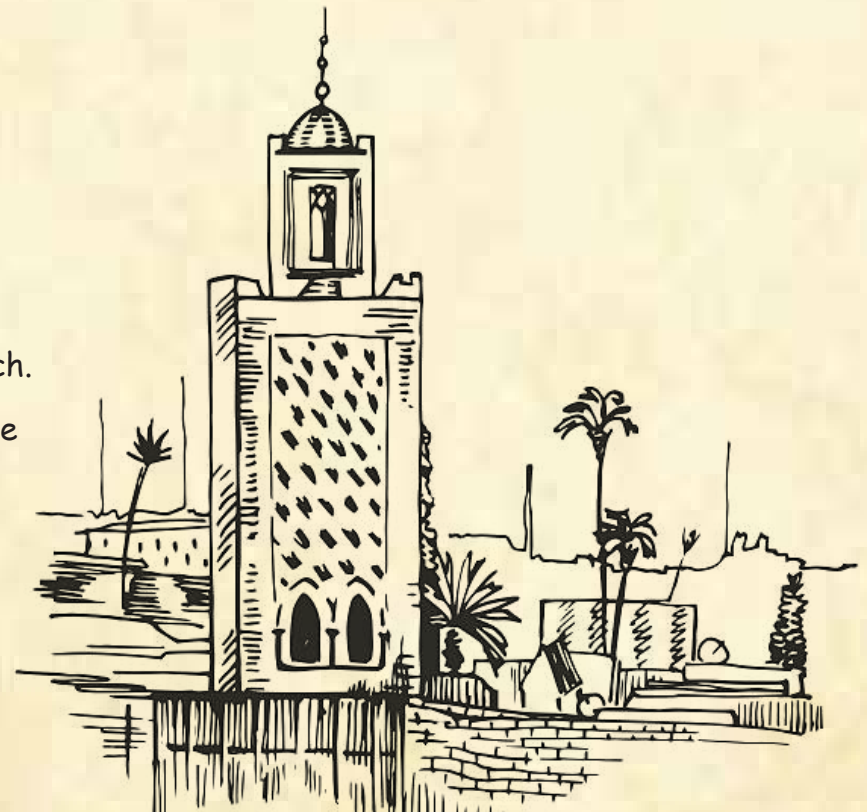
From Rabat, we drive through coastal cities including Sale, Temara, and Bouznika, enjoying scenic views of the Atlantic Ocean. We conclude the day with hotel check-in and dinner in Mohammedia.

DAY 6: MOHAMMEDIA – MARRAKECH

After breakfast, we embark on a 3-hour drive to the lively city of Marrakech. Upon arrival, we check in at the hotel and freshen up before heading out to explore the city.

We begin with a visit to Jemaa el-Fnaa, the main square of Marrakech, bustling with performers, vendors, and local artisans. We then visit the Saadian Tombs, a historical site with beautifully decorated mausoleums. Our next stop is



the Koutoubia Mosque, an architectural landmark with lush gardens surrounding it. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant, where you can sample traditional Moroccan dishes such as tagine or tanjia.

DAY 7: MARRAKECH – ATLAS MOUNTAINS

In the afternoon, we head to the Atlas Mountains, located about 40 km from Marrakech. We enjoy lunch at the Ourika Valley, a scenic region known for its breathtaking landscapes and charming Berber villages. After lunch, experience Berber hospitality by sharing tea with a local family. Dinner will be served at a restaurant back in Marrakech.

DAY 8: MARRAKECH – CASABLANCA – CAIRO

We depart early in the morning for Casablanca Airport (CMN) to catch our flight to Cairo, Egypt. Upon arrival in Cairo, our friendly tour manager will meet you at the airport and assist with immigration formalities.

We begin our Egyptian adventure with lunch, followed



by a visit to the Pyramids of Giza and the Sphinx. In the evening, enjoy the Sound and Light Show at the pyramids, immersing you in Egypt's ancient history. After dinner, we check in at the hotel for an overnight stay.

DAY 9: CAIRO – ASWAN (FLIGHT)

After breakfast, we take a flight from Cairo to Aswan. Upon arrival, we visit the High Dam and the Philae Temple, dedicated to the goddess Isis. We also explore a Nubian village, offering insights into local culture and traditions.

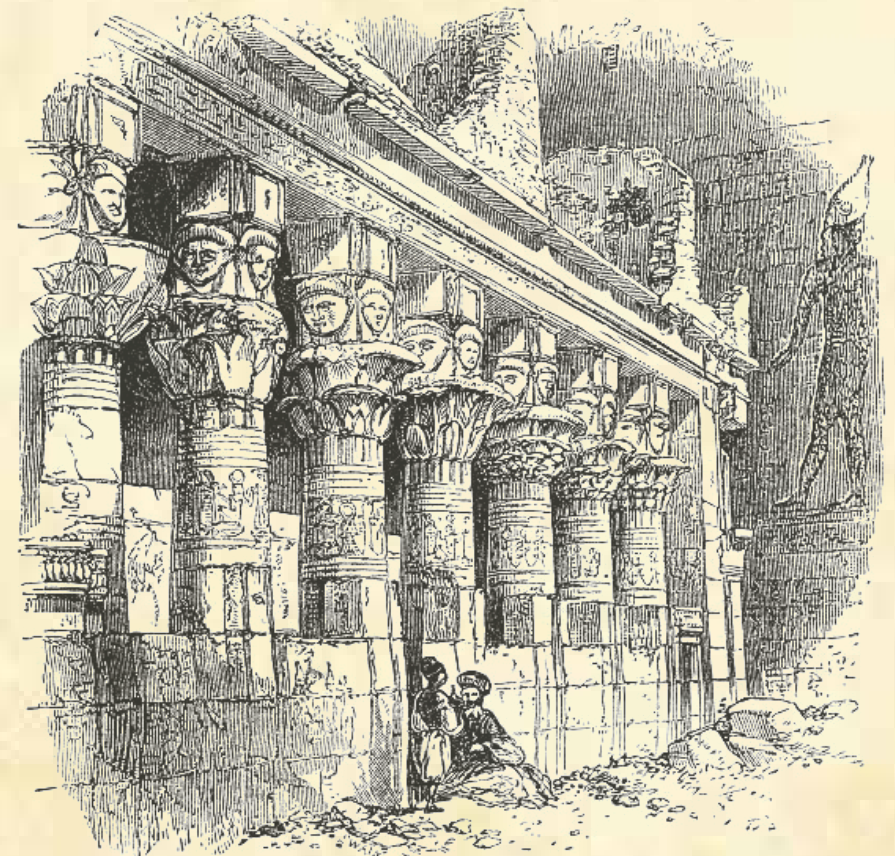

In the evening, the cruise continues toward the East Bank of Luxor.
